Manages House Tutor time effectively

Demonstrates exibility and adjusts a session if needed

CREATE AND MAINTAIN A SUPPORTIVE, SAFE AND MOTIVATING ENVIRONMENT

Addresses misbehaviour quickly and effectively

Is a role model in behaviour, conduct and dress

Allows time for students to answer questions and discuss ideas

Respects students' ideas, suggestions and opinions

Senses and responds to the mood of the group

Is consistent and fair in their dealings with students

Accepts responsibility for their own mistakes and acts accordingly
